A NOTE FROM FATHER JASON

It seems that on most days, time is moving faster than I am. After all, it seems like Christmas was not that long ago and now Lent has begun. Days fly by and although many things are accomplished, there is always the regret that other things were not accomplished by the deadline that I had imposed on myself. Such is the reality of life... we tackle the challenges of each day and are often unaware of just how fast the days slip by and how we tend to fall into the same habits, the same coping mechanisms, and the same responses

to the challenges that each day brings.

Because it is so easy to slip into routines in our lives, it is easy to forget that we should be constantly working to improve ourselves, especially when it comes to responding with all our heart to the One whose love for us is infinite. Lent arrives every year to remind us of the need to push ourselves and even to be pushed to go deeper in our spiritual lives. Lent is an opportunity to slow down, to listen for the Lord, and to give a little more back to Him.

Lent does demand certain things: 2 days of fasting, six Fridays of abstinence from meat, the duty of making a pre-Easter confession, and extra efforts to pray, to fast, and give that we choose to undertake. These things do prepare us for Easter in that they remind us of the price Jesus paid for us. But Lent is not simply meant to be a time of rules that make us feel bad.

Lent can be something more if you move yourself past seeing the 40 days as a time of demands and regulations into seeing it as a time of opportunity. Lent gives you opportunities to be more generous and giving. The extra prayers and devotions such as stations of the cross, the "Together in His Footsteps" booklets, the "Catholic and Christian" books that were given at Christmas are all opportunities that you can use to push yourself to set a little time aside each day for prayer and learning about God. Even the Lenten call to fasting is an opportunity. The practice of giving something up causes you to have more control over yourself, your choices, and your habits.

The potential and possibilities for you during these forty days are endless. The time may seem long, but like all time it will pass us by so quickly. Be courageous! Seize the opportunity that is Lent. Whatever effort you make will help you to break the momentum of time passing by and help you to grow toward that goal of being the good person God created you to be, with His help.

May God bless you in this Holy Season of Lent, with its many opportunities and all of the abundant graces which the Lord has waiting for you,

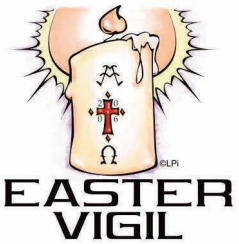

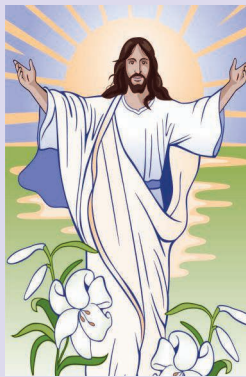

MQH COUNCIL OF CATHOLIC WOMEN "Woman of the Year" Nominations Weekend of March 4th and 5th

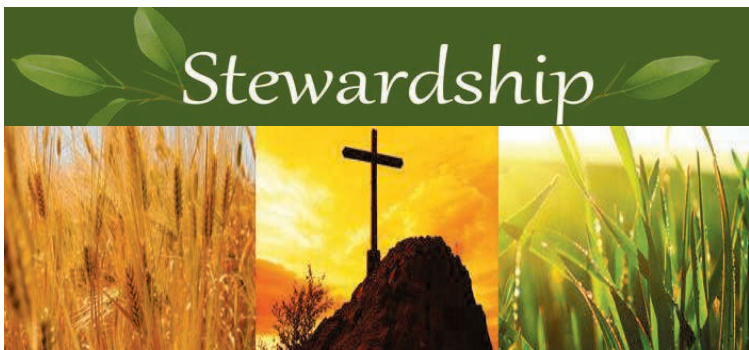

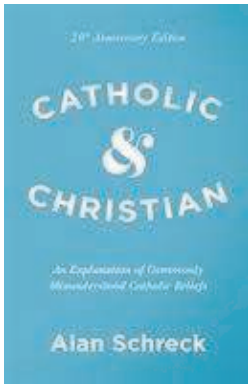

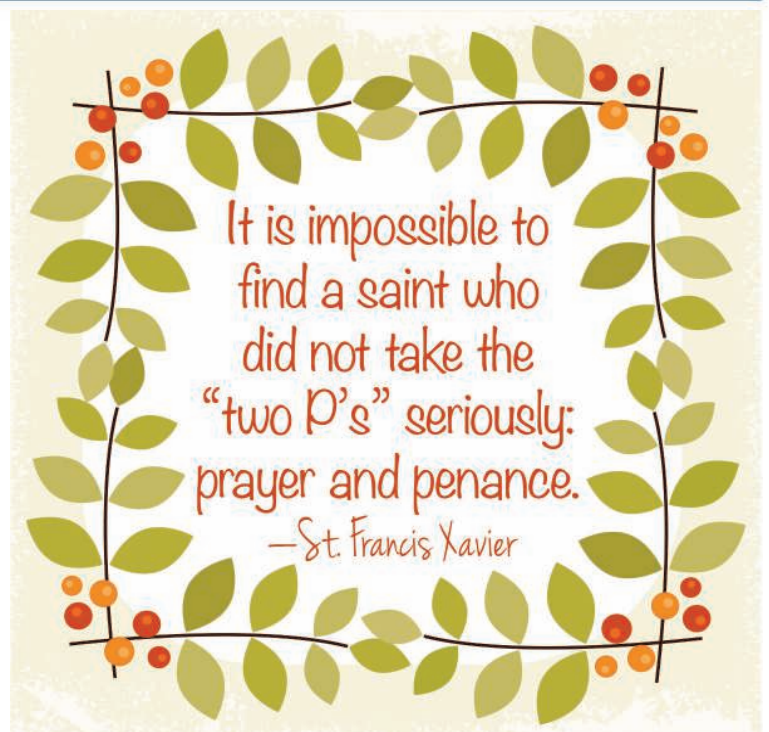

Lenten Disciplines of Fasting & Abstinence

Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Fasting consists of eating only one meal, with the possibility of two smaller snacks that do not add up to a single full meal.

Catholics age 14 and older are to abstain from meat on all Fridays in Lent.
