## A NOTE FROM FATHER JASON

This Sunday is the date of the feast of Saint Joseph. I always feel a little for Saint Joseph. He always seems to end up on the short end of things. He is the one member of the Holy Family not in possession of a privilege of grace to be free from sin, not one word of his is recorded in the Gospels, and he fades into the background after the Presentation of Jesus. This year, his feast day even gets moved. March 19th is the usual day to celebrate his feast. However, this year it falls on a Sunday, so once again Saint Joseph gets pushed aside, this year being observed on Monday the 20th. What else would we expect from he who is known to us as a model of humility?

Even though his feast day will take second place to Lent, it is a good time to consider his example and seek his help, even in the work of Lent. Saint Joseph's work ethic is one of the major areas that people turn to him in devotion. It is good to seek his help and intercession to guide us in our work, to help us to be faithful to the tasks assigned to us, and even in seeking work that allows us to use our gifts and talents well.

The other aspect of Joseph's life that stands out is his role as father. He is venerated for how he accepted Jesus as his own, teaching Jesus with a father's love and patience. Unfortunately, we live in a society that often does not give fatherhood the respect and support that it deserves. As such, praying to Saint Joseph to seek his help and intercession for all those we know who are living the vocation as father is always needed and fruitful.

Blessed Joseph, husband of Mary,  
be with us this day.  
You protected and cherished the Virgin;  
loving the Child Jesus as your Son,  
you rescued Him from the danger of death.  
Defend the Church,  
the household of God,  
purchased by the Blood of Christ.

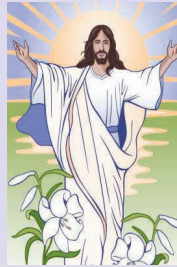

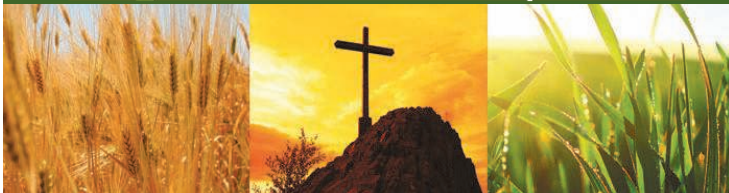

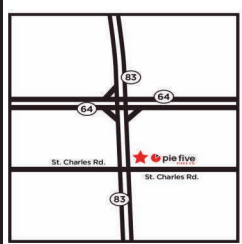
