A NOTE FROM FATHER JASON

In 2015, Bishop Conlon together with the Diocesan Pastoral Council released a “Framework for Pastoral Action.” The framework is the result of years of study and gathering input from various groups within the diocese. The goal of the framework is to highlight the areas that all Catholics within our diocese should be working and praying to strengthen within their parishes and the Church throughout our region.

The framework’s overall theme is “Go and Make Disciples.” It is organized around three pillars: Discipleship, Evangelization, and Charity. Within each pillar, areas of focus have been identified:

Pillar of Discipleship

- 1) Cultivate a personal encounter with Jesus in order to joyfully share the Gospel as a knowledgeable and responsible disciple.
- 2) Inspire young adults to participate as lay leaders in the mission of the Catholic Church.
- 3) Embrace immigrant Catholics and encourage their development as leaders in the Church.

Pillar of Evangelization

- 1) Seek, invite, and welcome Catholics who have drifted away from the Church.
- 2) Emphasize and outwardly proclaim the importance of the sacraments and all vocations.

Pillar of Charity

- 1) Go outside your church doors to care for people in need.
- 2) Advocate for and with people in need as the Gospel instructs you to do.

When the framework was first distributed to us, I discussed it with the parish council. That discussion led to our “Feeding the Hunger” initiative and events last year. In addition, the stewardship weekend last fall was an effort to increase participation in the ministries at Mary Queen, in order to move toward a greater parish-wide awareness of each member’s call to be disciples, evangelizers, and good stewards.

To gauge each parishes’ activity within the framework, the Bishop and Diocesan Pastoral Council are seeking a formal evaluation of our status in each of these areas as well as areas where goals can be set to promote progress in the pillars and areas of focus. I have been conducting conversations within our councils to begin assembling this information. Of course, such an effort would be incomplete without input from the entire parish.

It is for that reason that the parish council has invited you to participate in a survey where you can share your sense of our parish, it’s strengths and weaknesses, and your ideas for areas where we can grow, especially in the areas that the framework has encouraged us to consider setting new goals.

The survey can be found online at: www.maryqueensurvey.com. The site is desktop and mobile friendly. Paper surveys are available for those unable to go online. I encourage you to be as open and honest as you are comfortable being in responding to the questions. Our hope is for 125% participation. That means that I hope that not just everyone I see on Sunday sends input, but that you would invite other Catholics who live nearby and have some experience with Mary Queen to participate as well. If you know someone who has moved away or is now attending a different church, they are also encouraged to go to the survey. All constructive feedback and ideas are welcome. The more information we gather, the better our goals will be in guiding our efforts to as a parish in the future.

Thank you for your time, participation, and ideas! May God bless your efforts to grow and to help your fellow parishioners grow in discipleship, evangelization, and charity.

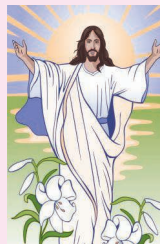

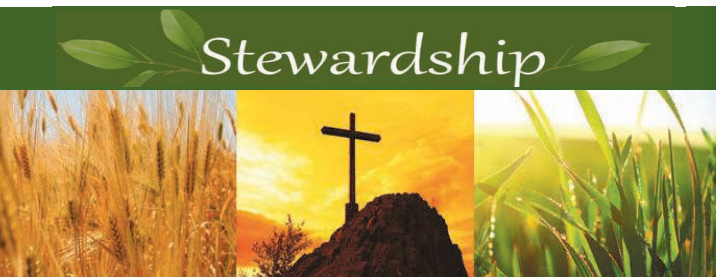
